I hope this newsletter finds you well and rejoicing in the Lord's work. We count it a joy to be serving the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords, here in Camden NJ where the battle is ruff. A lot has happened since our last letter; the decision has been made, there will be no more Camden police department as of some time this spring. They will be replaced by county police who will use more cameras than able bodies. One of the reasons are the funding is not there to pay these officers. They also say the police force has not been that effective in the city. Once again Camden is the most dangerous city and the poorest in the Country.

As you know, in December we purchased a building in south Camden. The building was used as a church but was never zoned as one. We have submitted the paper work to get the building zoned as a church. The president of the zoning board told me he would get it passed (but our confidence is not in him it's in the Lord). Psalms 118:8 it is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man. In the mean time we are working on the electrical and plumbing. Heating and air conditioning will cost us around 15,000. We have a little over 10,000 still in our account. Also since our last news letter we have seen a girl named Gloria who is 15 and her younger brother Lorenzo make a profession of faith. We met them when I gave their mother a track and she called me to see if I could help them with furniture, and to talk to her daughter Gloria, who would leave home and wouldn't come back for days. Please pray for them. Also a young couple, Emily and Rob have been coming out, please pray for their salvation.
